

BIG INCREASE IN GP BULK BILLED VISITS

GP Bulk billing rates are up by 8% across the Bendigo Electorate

Central Victoria is reaping the rewards of the Federal Labor Government's record investments into Medicare, as new data shows bulk billing for GP appointments has increased by 8% in the Bendigo electorate since November 1st 2023.

This is great news!

On November 1st last year, the Government tripled the bulk billing incentive GPs are paid if they do not charge a gap fee for children and Commonwealth concession card holders.

Bulk billing is the beating heart of Medicare, and the investment we have made into bulk billing has provided real cost-of-living relief to parents, pensioners and healthcare card holders.

Our Government is committed to rebuilding Medicare and strengthening the healthcare system for all Australians.









Boost to Services Australia staff means shorter wait times for Bendigo locals

In March, I welcomed Minister for NDIS and Government Services Bill Shorten to the electorate to announce an additional eleven full time positions for our local Services Australia office (formally known as Centrelink).



An extra 3,000 directly employed staff will be added to the department across the country, which will go a long way towards minimising frustrating wait times.

The Federal Labor Government understands your time is precious and is committed to restoring Services Australia, after years of neglect under the former Liberal government.

The announcement means less time spent on hold as more properly trained and directly employed staff will be available to answer your calls.

Bendigo locals who rely on social safety net payments and other supports such as childcare subsidies, will have an easier time accessing support when they need to contact Services Australia.

Endometriosis and Pelvic Pain clinic

Assistant Minister for Health and Aged Care, Ged Kearney MP, visited Bendigo on International Women's Day to officially open Bendigo's first specialised endometriosis and pelvic pain clinic.

This is one of the 22 Endometriosis and Pelvic Pain Clinics that have opened across Australia under the Federal Labor Government, and the first in regional Victoria.

Endometriosis affects at least 1 in every 9 Australian women, and women often suffer for years before getting a diagnosis. The Federal Labor Government cares about women's health and recognises pelvic pain and endometriosis as serious and debilitating health conditions.


Labor's Fairer Tax Cuts

The Saluting Their Service (STS) Commemorative Grants Program is designed to commemorate the service and sacrifice of Australia's service personnel and their families.

There are 2 categories of grants available under the program:

1. Community Grants (STS-CG) Grants to a maximum of \$10,000 are available for local, community-based projects and activities

2. Major Grants (STS-MG)

Grants between \$10,001 and \$150,000 are available for major commemorative projects and activities that are significant from a national, state, territory and/or broader regional perspective.
